RANCH HORSE COMPETITION & SALE

SUNDAY, JUNE 5TH, 2011

COMPETITION: 2:30 PM – STETTLER EXHIBITION GROUNDS
PREVIEW: 5:00 PM – SAS INDOOR ARENA
SALE: 7:00 PM – SAS INDOOR ARENA

- 1) Registered or unregistered saddle horses for competition and sale are accepted at a minimum of 5 years of age. 2, 3 and 4 year olds will be accepted for the prospect section.
 - 2) Sale order will start with competition winners in order of placing from 1st to 3rd and then remaining competition horses follow in catalogue order. Prospect horses sell in catalogue order.
 - 3) All sellers will provide a halter and lead rope with each horse. All horses to be shown under saddle in the sale ring.
 - 4) All competition horses must sell to receive prize money and awards. If the winning or placing horse does not sell, the prize money and awards go to the next high scoring horse.
 - 5) Competition fees will be \$300 plus a 5% sales commission. Prospect fees will be \$50 plus 5% sales commission.
 - 6) If a horse is passed out, the papers will be held until payment of the Pass Out fee: \$150 for each horse is collected by the SAS. For grade horses, a \$150 payment will be included with entry fees, to be reimbursed upon the sale of the horse.
 - 7) Deadline for application will be 5:00 p.m., Friday, April 29th, 2011.
 - 8) Selection Day will be held May 7th, 2011 at the SAS Indoor Arena
 - 9) Consignment Form: Consignment form, catalogue quality digital picture, original papers transferred into current consigners name and payment made out to Stettler District Agricultural Society must be received by April 29th before entry will be considered for selection. Competition horses will be limited to 12 horses.
Prospect horses will be limited to 12 horses. Prospect horses will be shown and sold under saddle.
 - 10) Nominators of horses not accepted by the pre-selection committee will be notified and the entire nomination fee will be returned.
 - 11) No substitute horses will be allowed to sell in place of a competition horse. No refunds will be given on fees paid on horses not at the sale once they have been catalogued.
 - 12) Consigners will supply their own feed, however stalls and bedding will be available at the SAS ground.
 - 13) All competition horses will compete prior to the sale and will be judged according to the competition rules.
